

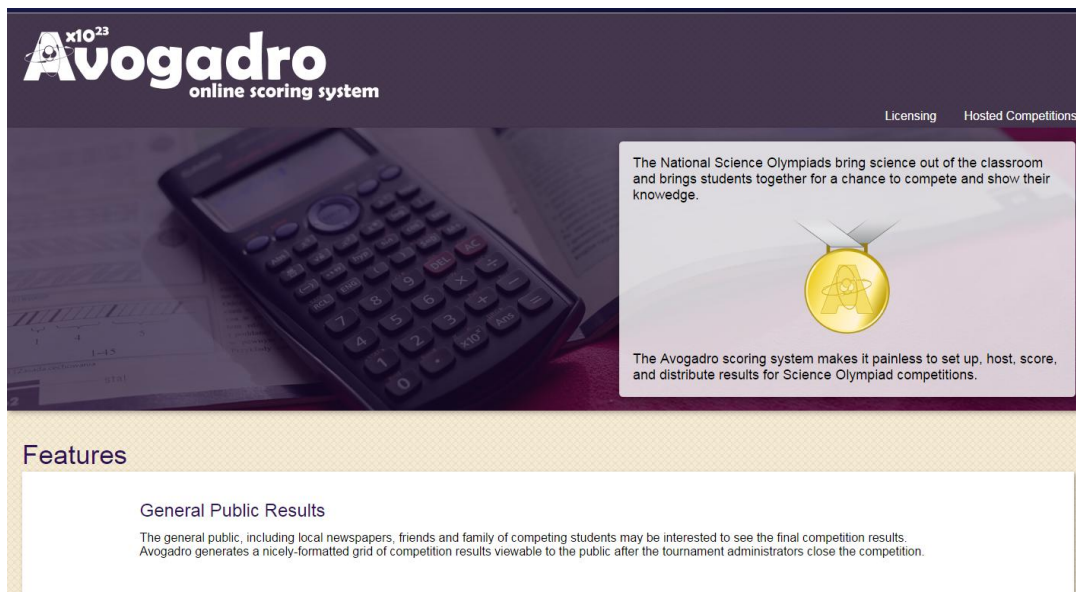
Avogadro User Guide for Creating an Account

Creating a User Account

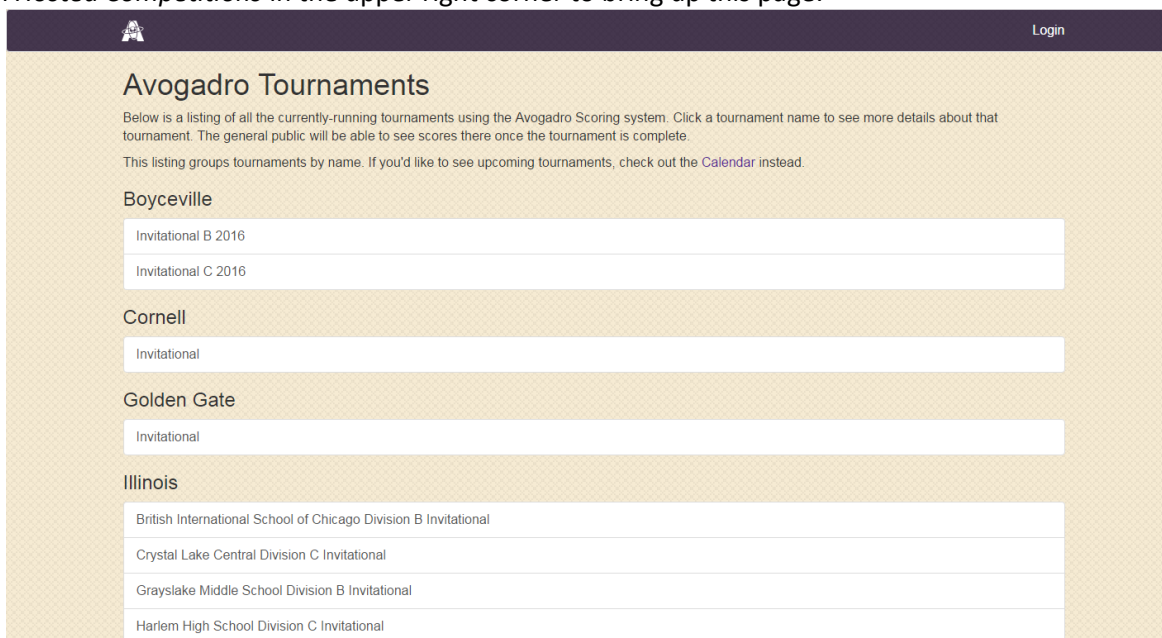
To use Avogadro as a coach, you first need to create an account. First, go to the home page of Avogadro:

The page will look like:

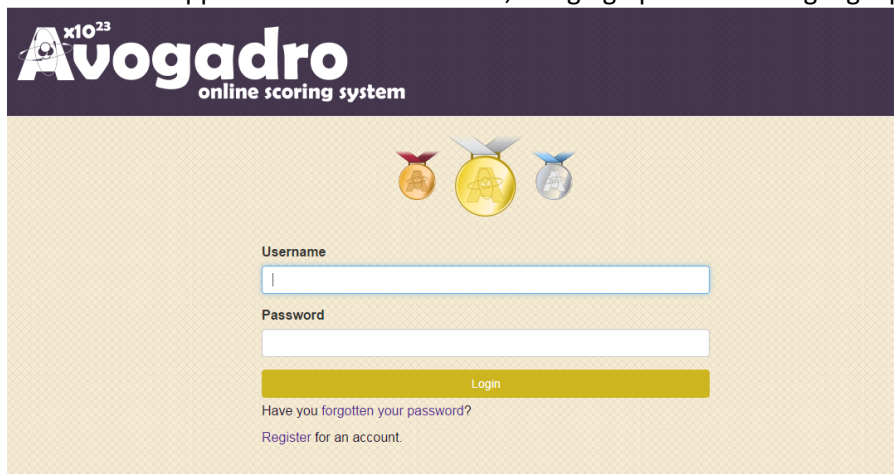


Click on *Hosted Competitions* in the upper right corner to bring up this page:

Click on the *Login* button on the upper left side of the screen, bringing up the following login page:



Now, click the *Register for an Account* link at the bottom, bringing you to the following page:

User Registration

Username

Password

Password must be longer than **ten characters**. Spaces are allowed; consider using a "passphrase" of several words together.

Password confirm

eMail address

Needed for user confirmation, and in case you forget your password.

Full Name

Used to identify you on the site to other users of the tournaments you participate in.

Fill in the form and click the *Register* button at the bottom. The following screen will come up next:

Registration Success

Your account has been registered, but it is not active immediately. You must confirm your email address before your account will become active. Check your email for an activation link.

Next, you need to log into the e-mail address you provided on the form above and open the e-mail sent to you from *Avogadro Account Activation*:

This email address was given as the primary contact for a new user account in the [Avogadro Scoring system](#). To activate your new account, click the following link:

Click on the link in the middle of the e-mail address  to activate your account. **THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT!**

When you click on that link, the following website will open:

Success! Your account is now active; you can now [login](#) with it.

Now, click on the *login* button to log into Avogadro.

Next, **if you are a coach**, you need to e-mail your username to the tournament director so that your team(s) at the Science Olympiad tournament can be connected to the Avogadro user account you just created.

Once you log in, you will come to the Avogadro User Account Home Screen:

Paid Accounts

As a user in the Avogadro system, you are able to participate in other people's tournaments in various roles. In order to host your own tournament, you must sign up for a paid account. Each paid account can have several tournament instances created within it and should serve as a logical cluster of tournaments (some extensions act on all instances in an account cluster).
